

Public Acknowledgment of ENP Funding & Support

As stated in the commitment document, public acknowledgment is a requirement to receive funding or support from ENP. This also applies when support is indirect, for instance through communication assistance.

Public acknowledgment shows how ENP's funds are being spent, raises public understanding of neuroscientific research, and can provide us with a valuable rationale to keep on assisting researchers and students in a tangible way.

Acknowledgment and recognition of ENP funding and support should be communicated in an effective and consistent manner. These guidelines are designed to assist students and researchers in publicly acknowledging the assistance they receive from ENP.

We also thank students and researchers in advance for sending to ENP office their publications (books, leaflets, presentations, etc) and mention to us when their work is highlighted on the web.

1 When and Where

Recipients should acknowledge support in all their public activities and in documents related to the supported project. Activities include training sessions and workshops, as well as awareness-raising and promotion (lectures, speeches, symposia, etc.). Documents include those for distribution to project participants, as well as those for information and promotion purposes.

A When

Once funding for a project has been approved, recipients have many opportunities to acknowledge the support they receive, including at the public announcement, launch or conclusion of a project; and in media interviews.

B Where

Recipients must acknowledge ENP funding and support in their project communication and project-related products including:

- published material (news releases, bulletins, brochures, periodicals, books, booklets, leaflets, invitations, posters, workshops' participants handbooks and guides, public notices, electronic data, etc);
- audio-visual productions and expositions (films, videotapes, videodiscs, PowerPoint presentations, Web sites, displays and exhibits).

2 How: Suggested credits

A Written

When ENP is one among many contributors, document must bear at least a credit line or mention and/or ENP logo depending on the whole document layout.

Publications

Examples:

- Funding of the research of XX is from the Inserm, Université Pierre et Marie

Curie, Agence Nationale de la Recherche (ANR-XXXXX) and European Commission (FP7-XXXXXX). **The team of XX is part of the École des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France network.**

- This work was supported by Institut National de la Santé et de la Recherche Médicale, Université Pierre et Marie Curie, the Fondation M. XX XX, DIM Neuropôle (Région Île de France); Agence Nationale pour la Recherche (ANRXXXX), **École des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France** and NIH/XXXXXXXX.
- Recipient of the ENP Graduate Program fellowship from École des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France.

B Oral presentations

To acknowledge funding or support from ENP, recipients can use a credit line which best suits their situation: whether support is provided in a financial or an indirect form, whether ENP is the only contributor or one among many, regarding the linguistic environment, etc.

Examples:

- I gratefully acknowledge financial support from Ecole des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France ENP Starting Grant Program / ENP Graduate Program.
- My colleagues and I gratefully acknowledge communication support from Ecole des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France ENP Scientific Meetings Program.
- My laboratory gratefully acknowledges financial and material support from Ecole des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France ENP Post Doc Program.
- I gratefully acknowledge funding from Ecole des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France.
- Je remercie l'École des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France pour son soutien financier dans la cadre du Graduate Program de l'ENP.
- Je rappelle que mon équipe appartient au réseau ENP, Ecole des Neurosciences de Paris Ile-de-France.
