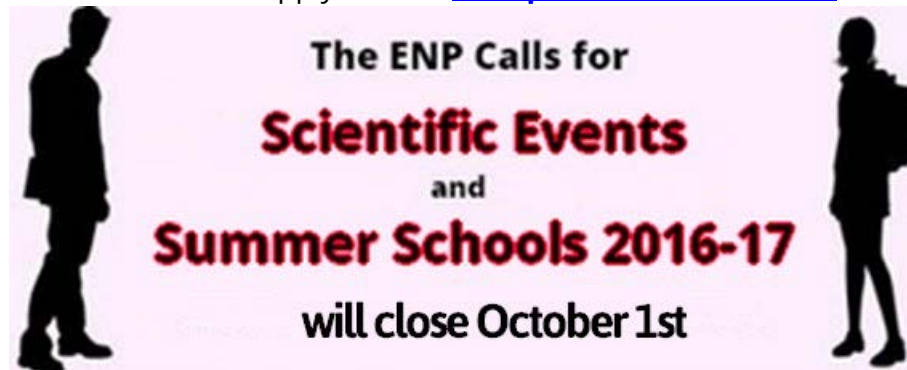


2016 ENP CALLS FOR SCIENTIFIC EVENTS AND SUMMER SCHOOLS

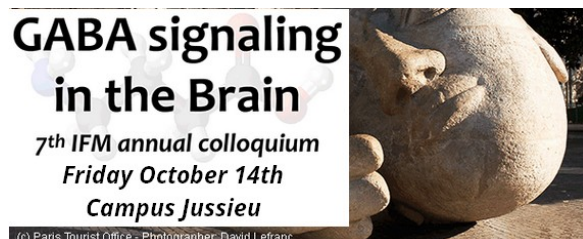
