

POST DOCS

The ENP Post Doc Program is a short-term solution to cover salary expenses for a limited period: it acts as a buffer before the team receives other grants and long-term support. This kind of support is meant to facilitate ENP teams' efforts to attract promising Post Docs. As of today 29 scientists have started their career in one of our network's teams.

APPLICATIONS

Submitted applications must include :

- Short application letter written by ENP team Principal Investigator
- A CV of the applicant and a list of his/her publications
- Two recommendation letters written by eminent scientists who know the applicant
- Research project presentation letter (2 pages max. in French or English)
- Recent publications of hosting team's members (10 pages max.)

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- Hosting team must be affiliated to ENP
- Pending approval of applications to other sources of financial support
- Post Doc applicant must have been working abroad for at least 2 years
- Confirmed scientific excellence (courses, publications, and/or expertise in specific area of interest to ENP)

NEED-TO-KNOW

- Teams can be granted Post Docs funds 2 times only for 2 different candidates during their ENP affiliation.
- Applications can be submitted year-round and have to be approved by ENP Steering committee with external experts if necessary
- Applications must be sent by email to enp@paris-neuroscience.com
- Hosting ENP laboratory is responsible for all administrative formalities (visa, residence permit...) of the Post Doc
- Support is offered for a 3 to 6-month period via a fixed-term contract and a net salary of 2323 € / month.
