

Call for ENP Invited Scientists.

The objective of the ENP Invited Scientist Program is to give the opportunity to ENP Teams to host a foreign scientist for a few weeks up to 12 months. Aims are to advance a scientific project, to improve the scientific notoriety of the hosting research center (located in the Paris area) and to favor international multidisciplinary exchanges linked to the field of Neuroscience.

CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE INVITED SCIENTISTS

The invited researcher should agree to interact closely with his/her or hosting lab and with students from the ENP Graduate Program. He/she will participate in at least one ENP seminar and, if possible, will attend the ENPDAYS. The stay will take place in 2018, potentially continuing in 2019.

Applications will be reviewed by the ENP Steering Committee.

Applications must be completed by the hosting ENP team leader and submitted to enp@paris-neuroscience.com.

Deadline for the application: June 4, 2018

Decision: 30th June 2018

Submitted applications should include:

- A CV of the candidate with a list of recent publications (max.10)
- A summary of the scientific project (max. 10 pages)
- Proposed starting day and duration of the stay with a confirmation letter by the PI of the hosting lab.
- A short presentation (max. 1 page) of the research program to be carried out, stressing the benefits for the hosting lab and the ENP network. This document will be written by the candidate and the hosting ENP team leader.
- A financial plan describing any financial arrangements made by the candidate for the duration of his/her stay in Paris (*including financial resources provided by his/her home faculty for transportation, housing and the research project*).
- The ENP will cover all or part of the travel and lodging costs.
