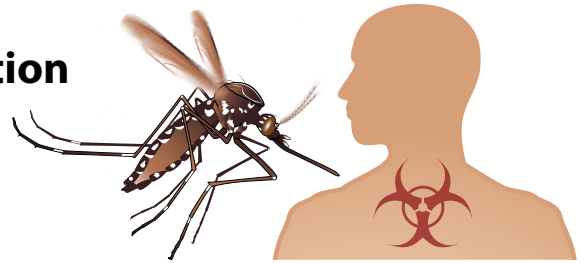




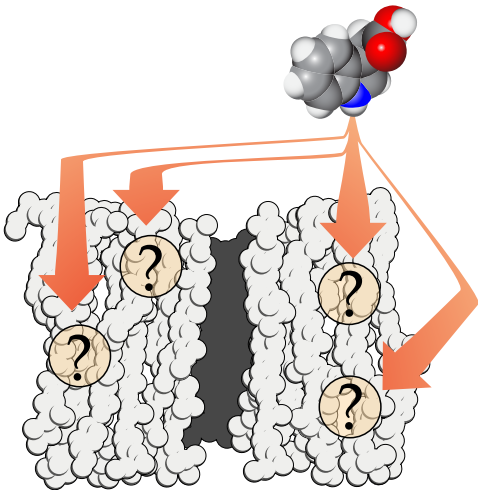
# Ph.D. position in Smell detection
